Smart India Hackathon 2020

All the students are hereby informed that Government of India has announced, Smart India Hackathon, 2020. It is a non-stop digital product development competition, where problems are posed to technology students for innovative solutions. **SIH2020 has undergone a major change and idea submission process is new this year.**

Important points for participation

- **Team leader would form a team of 6 including at least one female member as mandatory.**
- All team members should be from same college; **no inter-college teams are allowed.** However, **members from different branches of the same institute are encouraged to form a team.**
- The teams can come up with their own ideas against the problem statements and submit them to the SPOC. **Internal Hackathons** (college level) for teams that have submitted ideas would be held in the month **January 2020 (15-20 January).**
- SPOC will nominate **Total top 7 teams (selected from the Internal hackathon) to participate in SIH2020.** A college cannot nominate more than 7 teams under any circumstances. **7 teams would comprise of top 5 software teams and top 2 hardware teams** (including Student Innovation category) from each college.
- **Prize money** to be awarded to each winning team is **Rs. 100000/- per problem statement.** For more information visit <https://www.sih.gov.in>
