Computer Society of India is the first and largest national body representing computer professionals. It has 72 chapters across India, 511 student branches, and 100,000 members. The Society has developed a well-established network of "Student Branches" all across the country.

Objective- to enhance the skills of students and technical professionals for developing and applying technology to improve global conditions.

The activities conducted for the students associated with the Society include lecture meetings, seminars, conferences, training programmes, programming contests and practical visits.

The CSI Student Branches are mentored by Student Branch Counselor – typically a senior faculty member with good professional standing.
