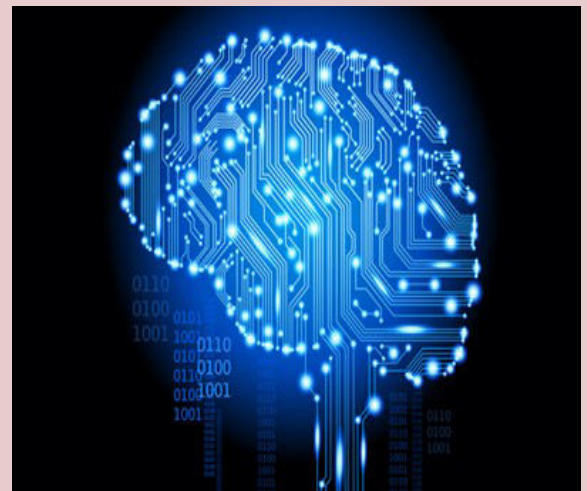

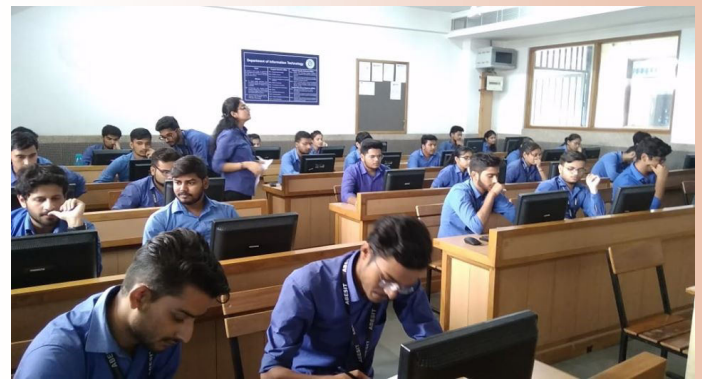
IT TECHNICAL CLUB EVENTS

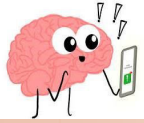

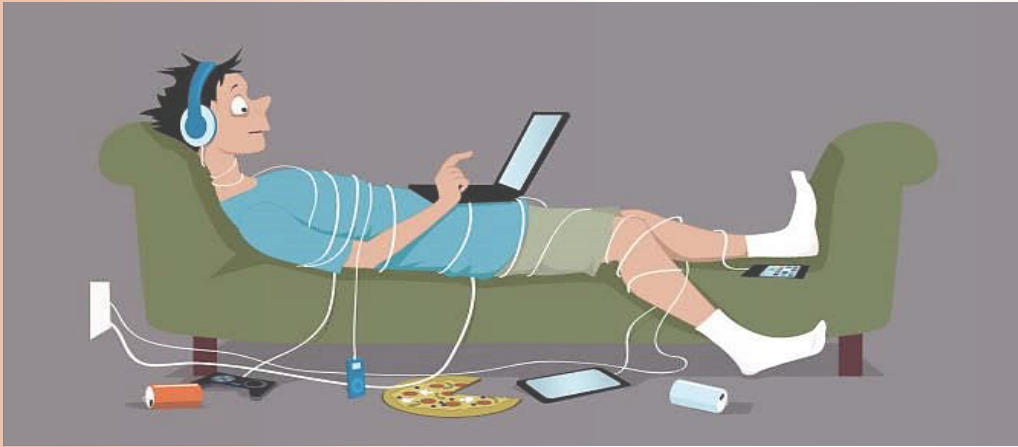
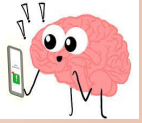
